CONTROL ACTION
Member to store considering flammable and following instructions for ventilation.
Instructions to be read and followed carefully during and after adhering graffiti proofer. Wear suitable and protective clothing as per the container.
Area to be sealed off with warning tape during spray and adhered during minimum period of use of bus shelters. Member to remain at site until area completely dry.
Secure asset where possible in storage and whilst using. Keep firmly away from children and animals.
Define at Parish Council Meeting process of maintenance - i.e. bench painted - varnished prior to anti-graffiti spray adhered. To consider where to administer - i.e. glass panels acceptable - to review if all panels should receive and if so ensure painted/ varnished if unable to administer maintenance after spray.
